

Baby Safety Checklist Widget



Nursery Safety

- Crib meets current safety standards (slats no more than 2 3/8 inches apart).
- Crib mattress fits snugly with no gaps.
- No soft bedding, pillows, or toys inside the crib.
- Mobiles and hanging toys are out of baby's reach.
- Changing table is sturdy with safety straps.
- All furniture is anchored to the wall to prevent tipping.
- Delegate the tip envelopes

Kitchen Safety

- Cabinet locks installed.
- Stove knob covers in place.
- Sharp objects and breakables stored out of reach.
- Trash can with a childproof lid.
- Refrigerator latch installed.
- Practice your vows
- Clear your to-do list!

Outdoor Safety

- Pool or pond has a safety fence with a self-closing, self-latching gate.
- Play areas are free from sharp objects and potential hazards.
- Sandbox is covered when not in use.
- Driveway is blocked off from the street.

Bathroom Safety

- Non-slip mats in the bathtub and on the bathroom floor.
- Water heater set to 120°F (48.9°C) or lower.
- Toilet locks installed.
- Medications and cleaning supplies stored out of reach or locked up.
- Electrical outlets covered.

Living Area Safety

- Electrical outlets covered.
- Blind cords are out of reach or have safety tassels.
- Furniture corners have bumpers.
- Fireplace has a safety gate.
- TV and other heavy electronics are anchored.

General Home Safety

- Stair gates installed at the top and bottom of stairs.
- Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors installed and tested regularly.
- Small objects, choking hazards, and toxic plants kept out of reach.
- Windows have locks and are free from cords.
- All cleaning supplies and chemicals are stored out of reach or locked up.

Emergency Preparedness

- First aid kit is stocked and easily accessible.
- Emergency numbers are posted near all phones.
- Home address is clearly visible from the street for emergency responders.
- Family has an emergency evacuation plan in place.
